Attend the public hearing for the Orange County Comprehensive Plan Update.

The Orange County Comprehensive Plan serves to guide the County's growth and development through the year 2030. By setting goals and objectives, County officials can use the document to guide policy decisions that effectively provide a high quality of life for residents.

The upcoming public hearing is the last public forum for the County to gather public input on the draft plan prior to adoption.

At the May 19 Public Hearing, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners will receive written and spoken input. After this hearing, the Planning Board will formulate recommendations for the Commissioners on adopting or making changes to the plan. The Commissioners are scheduled to consider adoption of the updated Comprehensive Plan at their August 19 meeting.
